RULES

1. For classes, all horses and ponies must be registered with, and competitors must be members

of, the BEF prior to the close of entries. Please visit our website to register if necessary.

2. Correct money for each class must accompany entry form.

3. The organizing committee reserves the right to change, cancel or combine classes or to deny inappropriate entries if they have reason to do so.

4. Competitors should be neatly and suitably attired in hunt cap with harness. Jackets are optional.

5. Braiding of horse or pony is not required.

6. Any cruelty or abuse, whether it is physical, verbal or otherwise, directed at any horse, person, or official of the show, will result in immediate elimination by the organizing committee. Refer to BEF Code of Conduct.

7. No person shall have any contact, direct or indirect, with any part of the fences in the main ring or the warm-up ring, while a horse or pony is jumping. Rapping a horse will result in elimination. No false ground lines may be used.

8. Any situation or condition not covered by the rules of the BEF will be decided by the Show Director.

9. All queries regarding registration of horses & memberships with the BEF are to be directed to membershipbef@gmail.com

10. Withdrawal of entries refer to BEF Rule Book. Any subsequent requests for changes must be directed to the Show Secretary.

11. List of requirements from which a judge may choose for an individual test in equitation classes may be found in the BEF Rule Book.

12. As this is a schooling show, BEF points will not be awarded at this show. BEF reference numbers are included in the prizelist for reference purposes only to detail how the class will be judged.

Ribbons will be awarded to 6th place.

ENTRIES

Enter the correct horse/pony registration number on the entry form where required as well as the BEF membership number of the rider. The age and date of birth of a junior competitor is also required. Entry forms without this information may not be accepted. Post entries will be accepted prior to the start of a class as provided in the BEF Rules. The age of a junior competitor will be taken as of September 1, 2023. A junior competitor shall be under 19 years.

Class 1 Open Hunter 2'3" Schooling Class

To be judged over a simple hunter course set at a maximum height of 2'3". No combinations will be on course, and all distances will be set using a standard 12' stride. Adults may ride ponies. A horse or pony may be ridden by more than one rider in this class. Manners, suitability of horse and rider, and performance to be judged.

Class 2 2'3 Hunter O/F (HU20) – To be shown over a course of no less than 8 fences not to exceed 2'3". Oxers not to exceed 18" in width are optional. Combinations are not permitted. To be judged on performance and soundness, suitability & manners.

Class 3 Low Equitation Over Fences (EQ14A & EQ14B) – To be judged over a course of no less than six jumps, the height of which should not exceed 2'3". Courses should include at least one change of direction and must not include a combination. To be judged 75% on the ability and performance of the rider, and suitability of the mount 25%. Stallions are prohibited. A horse or pony may be ridden by more than one rider in this class.

Class 4 Low Equitation Flat (EQ14A & EQ14B) – To be judged at a walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring, with the ability of the rider to be judged. Stallions are prohibited. .

Class 5 2'6 Hunter O/F (HU21) – To be shown over a course of no less than 8 fences not to exceed 2'6". Combinations are permitted. If horses and ponies are competing together, combinations will be adjusted accordingly. To be judged on performance and soundness, suitability & manners.

Class 6 Modified Equitation Over Fences (EQ15A & EQ15B) – To be judged over a course of no less than eight jumps, the height of which should not exceed 2'6". Courses should include at least one change of direction and may include a combination. Distances must be adjusted if horses and ponies are competing together in the same class. To be judged 75% on the ability and performance of the rider, and suitability of the mount 25%. Stallions are prohibited. A horse or pony may be ridden by more than one rider in this class.

Class 7 Modified Equitation Flat (EQ15A & EQ15B) – To be judged at a walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring, with the ability of the rider to be judged. Stallions are prohibited.

Class 8 2'9 Hunter O/F (HU22) – To be shown over a course of no less than 8 fences not to exceed 2'9". Combinations are permitted. If horses and ponies are competing together, combinations will be adjusted accordingly. To be judged on performance and soundness, suitability & manners.

Class 9 Open Equitation Over Fences (EQ16) – To be judged over a course of no less than

eight jumps, the height of which should not exceed 2'9". Courses should include at least one change of direction and must include a combination. Distances must be adjusted if horses and ponies are competing together in the same class. To be judged 75% on the ability and performance of the rider. A horse or pony may not be ridden by more than one rider in this class.

Class 10 Open Equitation Flat (EQ16) – To be judged at a walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring, with the ability of the rider to be judged.

Class 11 Riding Horse Combined (OT25 & OT26) - Entries to be shown under English saddle. Horses will enter the ring at walk and will be judge at the walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring. May be asked to hand gallop. Only eight (8) horses to gallop at one time. To be judged on performance, conformation, movement, substance and manners.

CLASS 12 X-Rail Hunter Schooling

To be judged over a simple hunter course set at a maximum height of 18". No combinations will be on course, and all distances will be set using a standard 12' stride. Adults may ride ponies. A horse or pony may be ridden by more than one rider in this class. Manners, suitability of horse and rider, and performance to be judged.

Class 13 Walk-Trot Equitation Over X-Rails (EQ11) – To be judged over a course of no less than six x-rails where the height in the centre of the x-rail should not exceed 12". Courses should include at least one change of direction and must not include a combination. Riders should jump each fence on the course at the trot. To be judged 75% on the ability and performance of the rider, and suitability of the mount 25%. Stallions are prohibited. A horse or pony may be ridden by more than one rider in this class.

Class 14 Beginner Equitation Over X-Rails (EQ12) – To be judged over a course of no less than six x-rails where the height in the centre of the x-rail should not exceed 12". Courses should include at least one change of direction and must not include a combination. Riders should jump each fence on the course at the canter. To be judged 75% on the ability and performance of the rider, and suitability of the mount 25%. Stallions are prohibited. A horse or pony may be ridden by more than one rider in this class.

CLASS 15 18" Hunter Schooling Class

To be judged over a simple hunter course set at a maximum height of 18". No combinations will be on course, and all distances will be set using a standard 12' stride. Adults may ride ponies. A horse or pony may be ridden by more than one rider in this class. Manners, suitability of horse and rider, and performance to be judged.

Class 16 Itty Bitty Hunter O/F (HU19) – To be shown at the canter over a course of no less than 8 fences not to exceed 18". Oxers not to exceed 18" in width are optional. At least one change of direction is required. Combinations are not permitted. To be judged on performance and soundness, suitability & manners.

Class 17 Short Stirrup Equitation Over Fences (EQ13A & EQ13B) – To be judged over a course of no less than six jumps, the height of which should not exceed 18". Courses should include at least one change of direction and must not include a combination. To be judged 75% on the ability and performance of the rider, and suitability of the mount 25%. Stallions are prohibited. A horse or pony may be ridden by more than one rider in this class.

Class 18 Short Stirrup Equitation Flat (EQ13A & EQ13B) – To be judged at a walk, trot and

canter both ways of the ring, with the ability of the rider to be judged. Stallions are prohibited.

Class 19 Leadline Equitation over Poles (EQ10) – To be led by a suitable handler over a course of no less than four poles with at least one change of direction. To be judged 75% on the ability and performance of the rider, and suitability of the mount 25%. Stallions prohibited. A horse or pony may be ridden by more than one rider in this class. The rider may not cross enter into any other class at the same horse show where they are not being led.

Class 20 Leadline Equitation Flat (EQ10) – Entries to be led at all times by a suitable handler. To be judged at a walk and trot only, with the ability and performance of the rider to be judged 75% and suitability 25%. Stallions prohibited. The rider may not cross enter into any other class at the same horse show where they are not being led.

Class 21 Walk-Trot Equitation Flat (EQ11) – To be judged at a walk and trot only, with the ability of the rider only to be judged. Any horse/pony, serviceably sound, that is suitable for riding, and is capable of performing required class routine, is acceptable. Stallions are prohibited. Riders may not cross enter into Beginner equitation flat at the same show.

Class 22 Beginner Equitation Flat (EQ12) – To be judged at a walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring, with the ability of the rider to be judged. Stallions are prohibited. Riders may not cross enter into the Walk-Trot Equitation flat at the same show.
